4. Consideration for the Environment

In order to maintain a comfortable and sustainable global environment, we will conduct optimal procurement activities to provide construction products and services that reduce the burden on the environment. These activities will include controlling emissions of waste, noise and vibration, greenhouse gases, environmental pollutants and hazardous materials, and maintaining good management conditions.

5. Respect for Human Rights and Building a Good Working Environment

We will strive to respect human rights as set out under international codes, eliminate all forms of discriminatory treatment, harassment, child labor, and forced labor, and conduct procurement activities on the premise of ensuring a good working environment.

6. Thorough Information Security

We will reject any dealings or any other relationships with antisocial forces.
